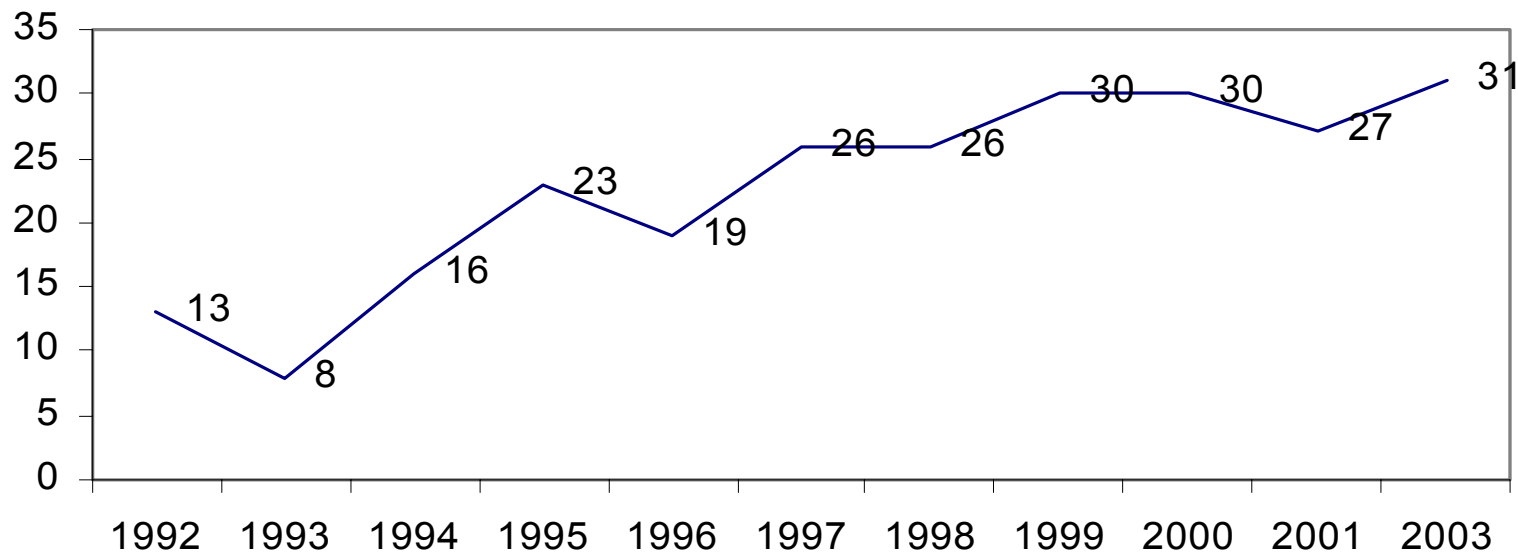

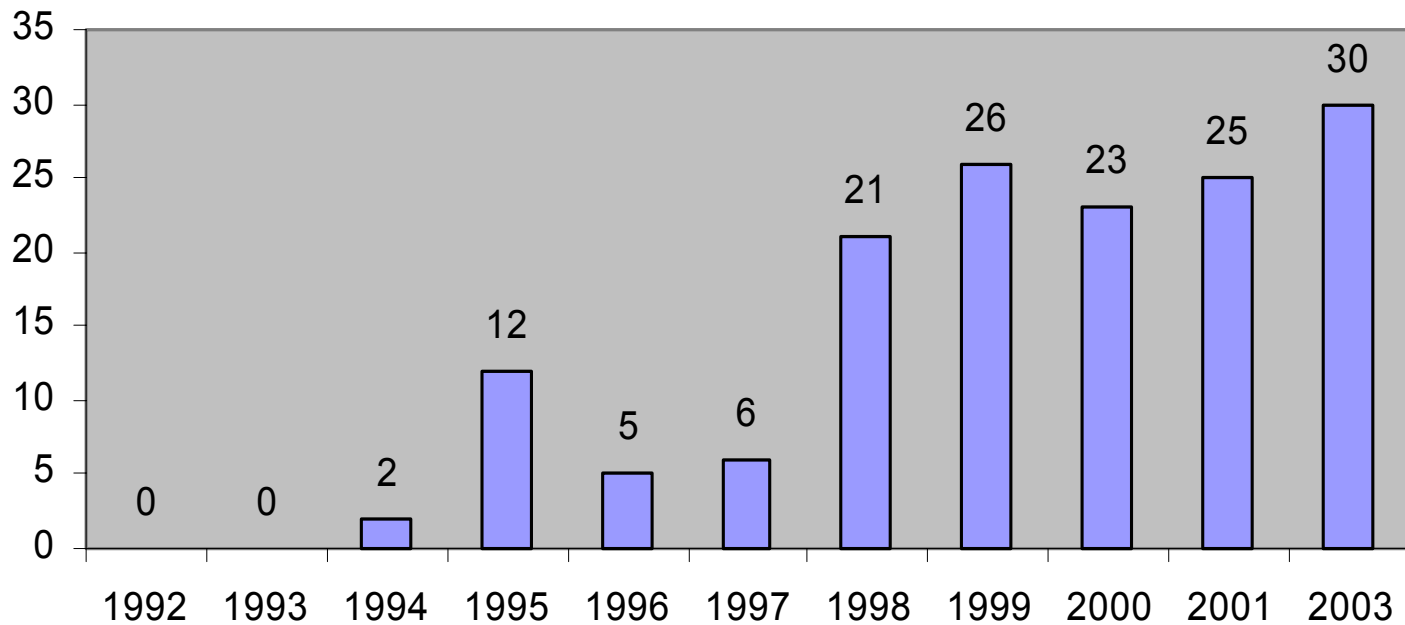

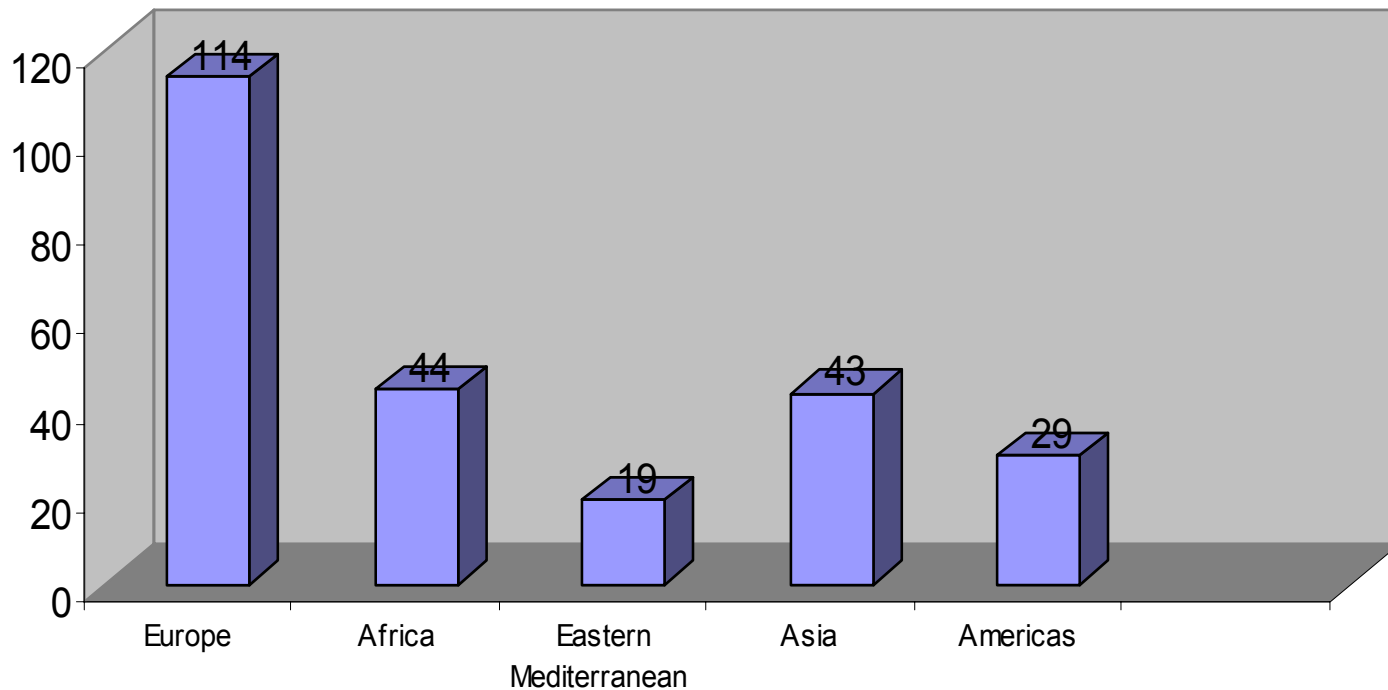

**PGC participants with Study Grant 1992-2003**



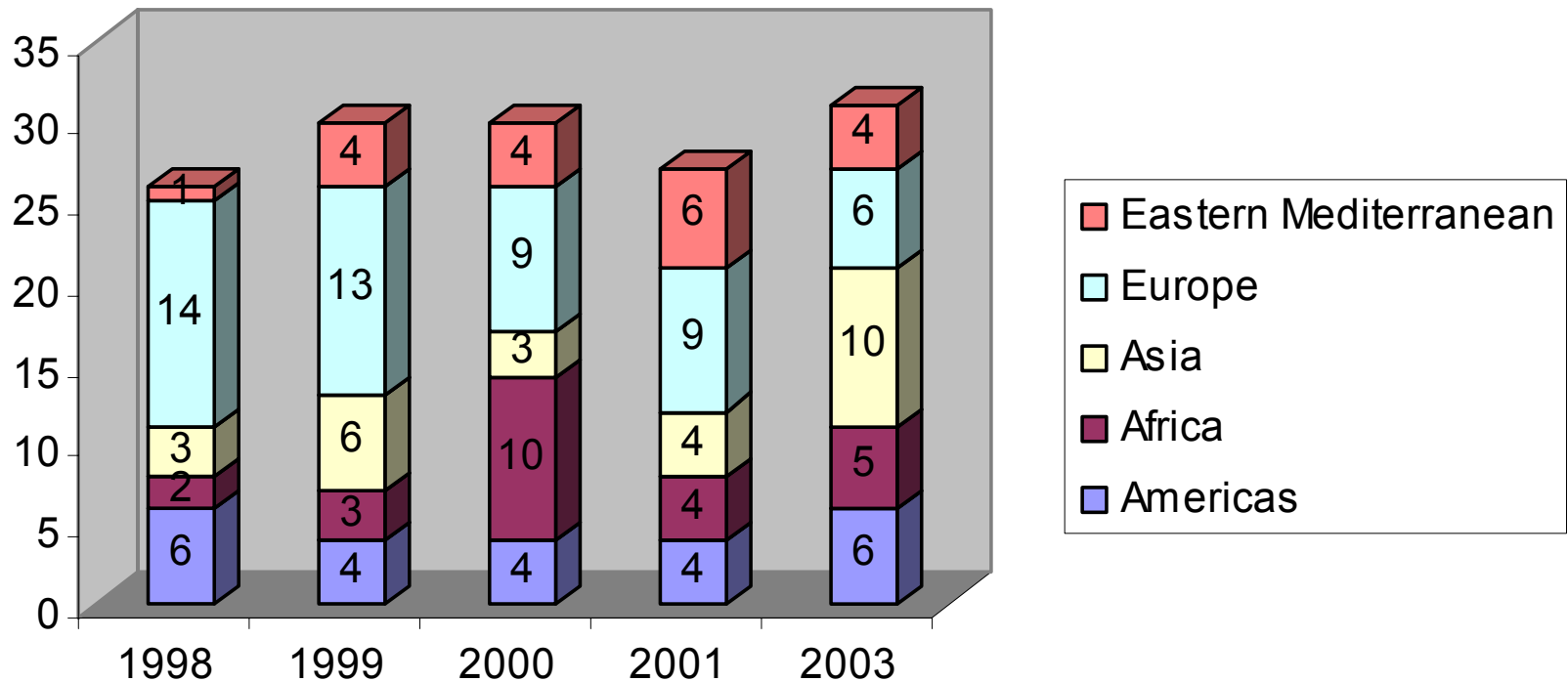

**PGC participants/region 1992-2003**



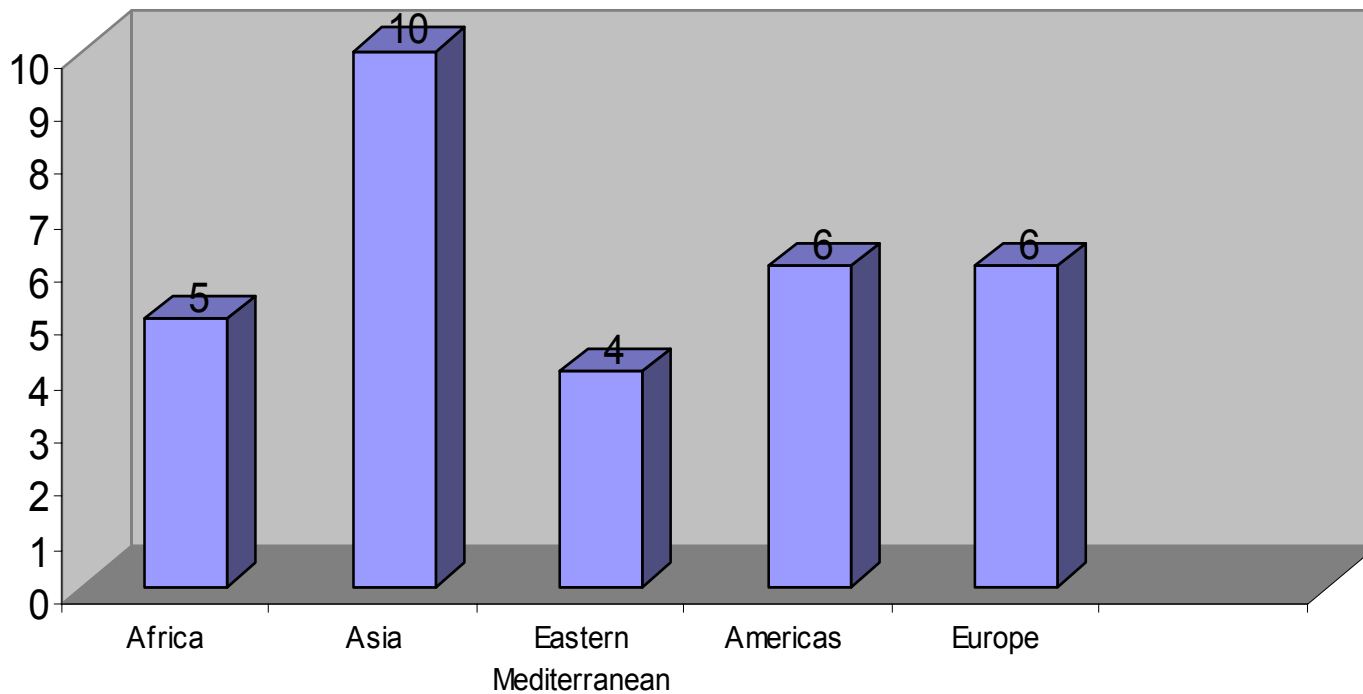

**PGC participants/region/year 1998-2003**



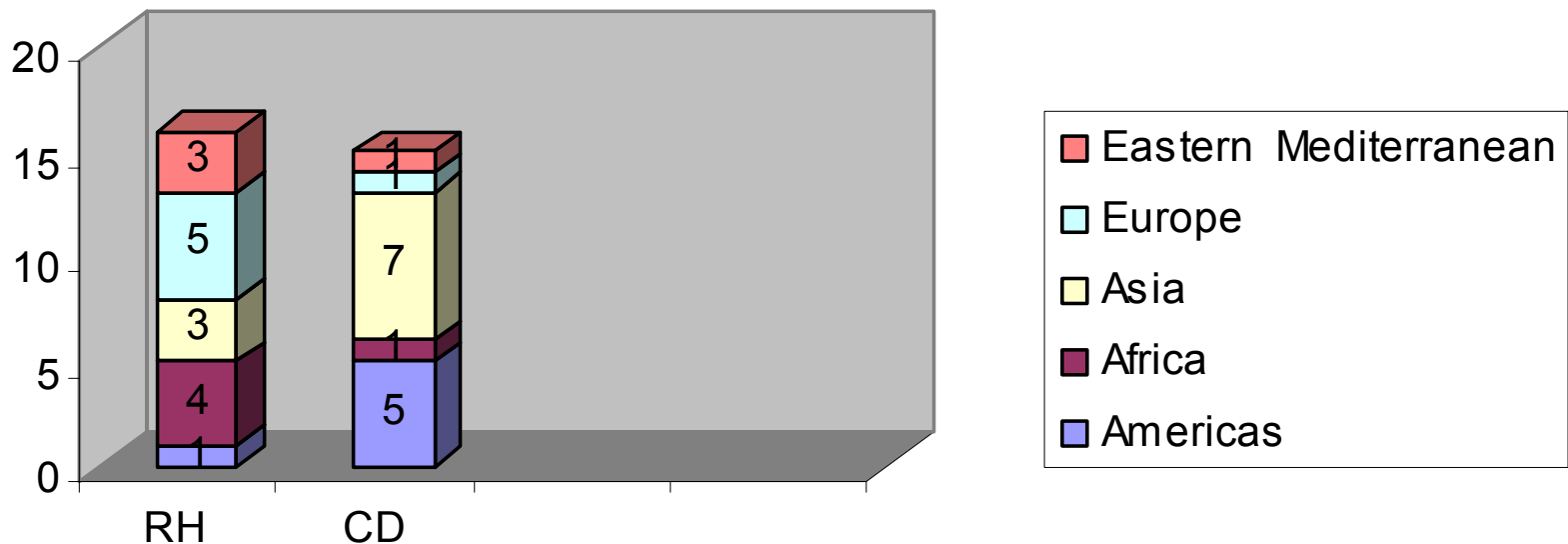

**PGC participants/region - 2003**



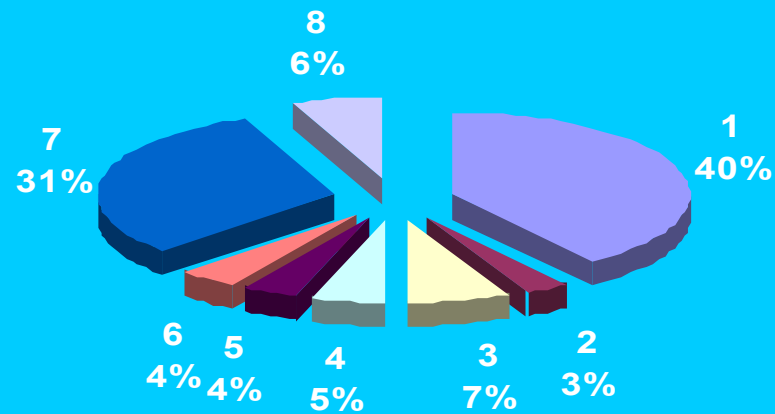
