

## **Introduction to OpenClinica and other web-based data management tools for health professionals**

OpenClinica is an open source web-based electronic data capture and management system for clinical research. Although it is user friendly and easy to set up an introductory hands-on course can be essential to helping you to build your own data management platform. Learn how to use this system for doing clinical data submission, validation and annotation, data filtering and extraction, auditing and reporting. This course also includes an overview of the HIPAA Security & Privacy (The health insurance portability and accountability act of 1996 to protect privacy and security of healthcare information) prominently in vigor in the United States. Learn how OpenClinica handles those issues, and what your system should take into consideration to align itself with those considerations.

Depending on the time available, this course can make a cursory introduction to other web-based data-management solutions including the solution developed at the GFMER Foundation.
