- To provide a European overview about management of STI with an insight to epidemiology, epidemiological tools and policy of Public health interventions
- To give a clinical updated overview on the main STIs and to describe the diagnostic process from the patient to the lab and back to the patient for a correct treatment
- To interactively discuss with participants clinical cases examining clinical, diagnostic, psychological aspects in the context of a Public health intervention directed to prevent disease complications and diffusion.

At the end of the course participants will achieve a level of knowledge that will enable them to properly manage the whole problem of STIs for patient and for public health

Working methodology: The course will consist in both a number of lectures given by expert scientists in the field, interactive group discussions, individual exercises and role playing.

Target audience: microbiologist and clinicians experts in infectious diseases, dermatologists, gynaecologists, neonatologists, laboratory technicians and public health professionals. Min 30- max 70 students

Languages: English – Italian. Simultaneous translation will be provided.
