<u>Summary:</u>

- Young parents involve in the decision of FGM more than before known.
 - Discussion arise about the value of FGM specially for female sexuality.
 - Tendency for abandon the practice of FGM/c among young generation.
- Two other study in Egypt show the effect of FGM/c on female sexuality dysfunction/vaginal dryness during intercourse/lack of sexual desire, less desire per week, less frequency of orgasm, difficulty reaching orgasm.
 - Recommendation for more call for research into all dimensions of FGM/c adverse effect.



To have baseline data on the problem of FGM/c among Sudanese women migrated to Switzerland

- To influence policy and practices

Objectives

Main objective :

To explore the effect of FGM on the sexuality of Sudanese women who migrated to Switzerland in the concept of sexual well being.

Specifics objectives:

- To assess the knowledge of Sudanese migrant women about FGM and its effect on their sexuality.
- To assess the Sudanese female migrants, attitude and perspective about their own sexuality.
- To detect the role of changing the environment and it influence to raise of socio-cultural pressure.

Research Questions

What is the degree of satisfaction or pleasure during intercourse in women with FGM?
 How does she define sex and related pleasures?

- 1. How important is sexual pleasure in her life?
- 2. How does she define pleasure in sex?
- Do women who have migrated to Switzerland practice (or plan to practice) FGM/c on their daughter? If yes then why?

Study Design and Methodology

- Type of methodology
 - Descriptive qualitative
 - Semi-directive interview
 - Sampling frame
 - Sample resource: community associations network checklist
 - Sample size
 - Study population: Every eligible woman will be included
 - Characteristics / socio-demographic stratification / operation sites

Report on sexuality aspect of FGM/C among the Sudanese women migrated to Switzerland by:

- Collecting and analyzing the responsiveness with the comparison of scientific definition of sexual dysfunction
- Long term consequences trends to abandon of FGM/C and well being
