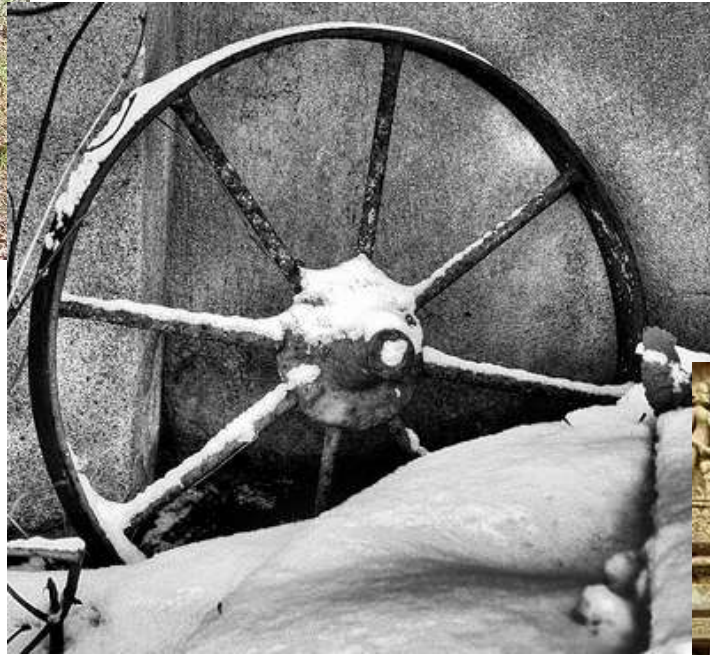
- The HINARI Access to Research Programme is coordinated by the World Health Organization (WHO)

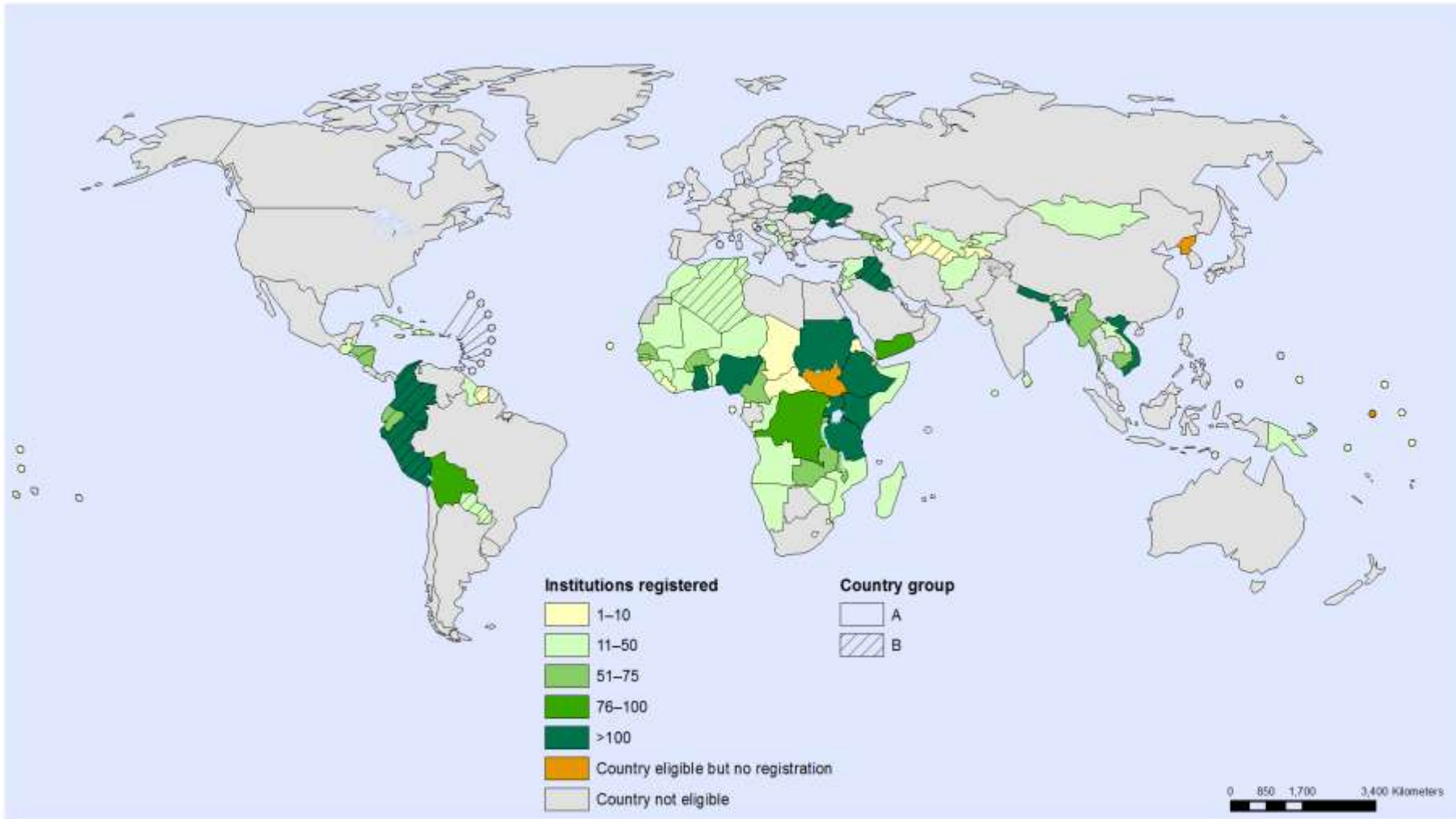

Eligibility/Registration (01 2012)

- Institutions in countries with GNI (gross national income) per capita below \$1600 or HDI (human development index) less than 0.63 are eligible for free access (Group A)
- Institutions in countries with GNI per capita between \$1601-\$5000 or HDI less than 0.67 pay a fee of \$1000 per year (Group B)
 - Some publishers opt out of this option and do not allow access to their journals

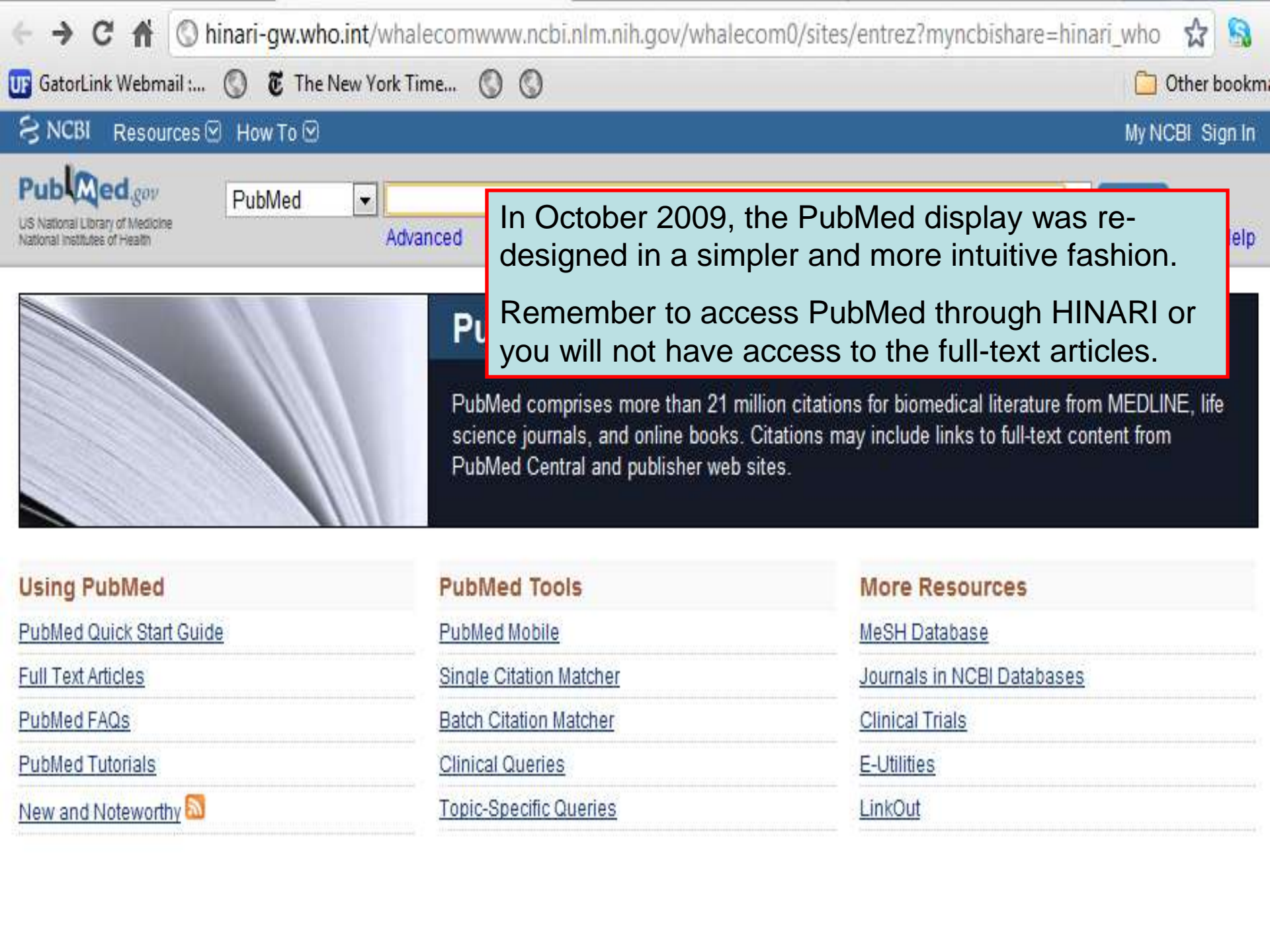

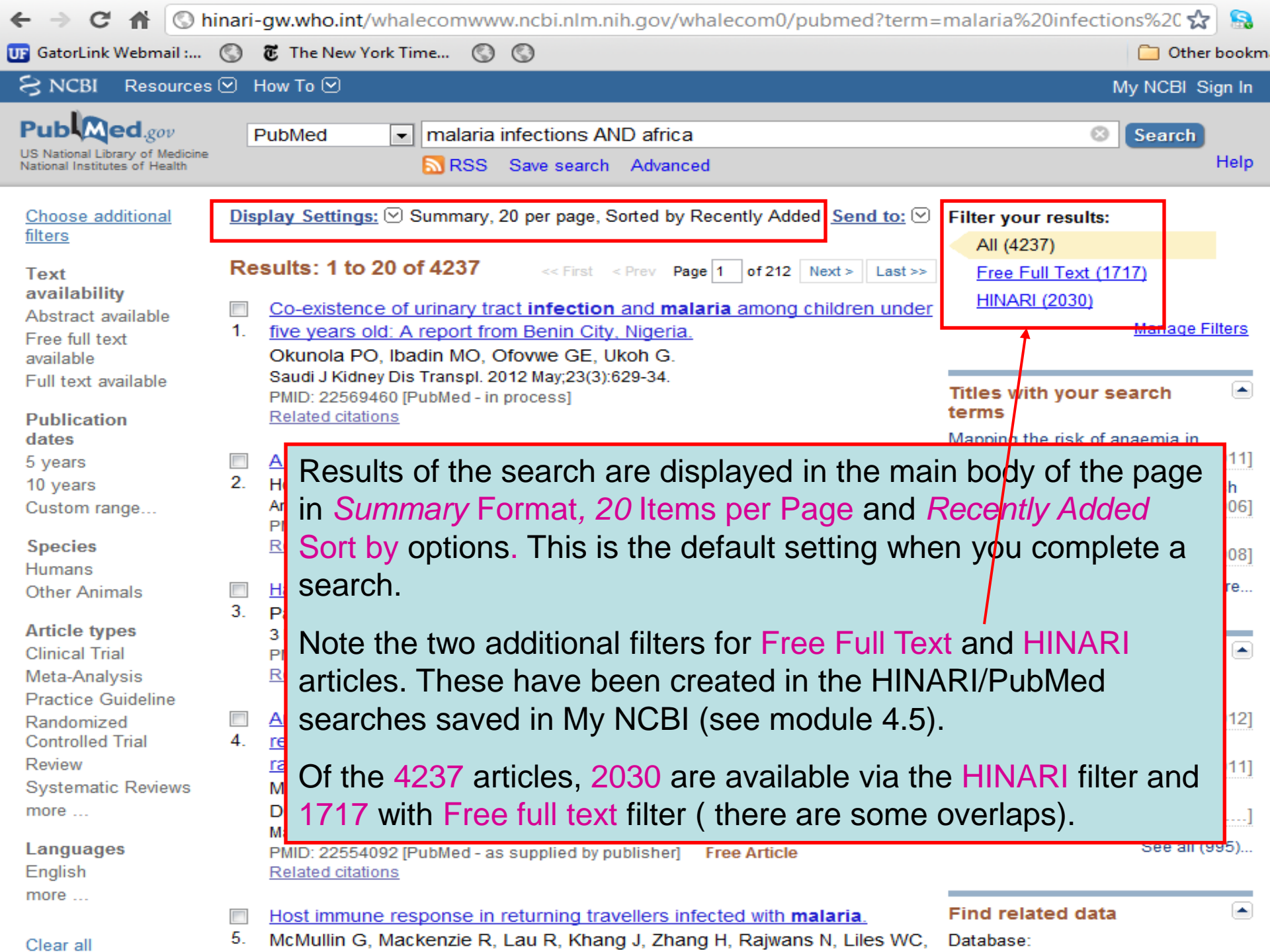
