1. How can I find the course modules and course files?

- a. Click on <u>SRH course 2011</u> on the <u>GFMER home page</u>. You will find a sitemap of the course website, including the course modules. Click on the required module to view the course files. You will also find references, relevant online documents and resources for the course. Click on whichever is applicable.
- b. Click on <u>Training Course in Sexual and Reproductive Health Research 2011 What's new?</u> on <u>SRH course 2011</u>. All published course files are included in this list according to dates. They are also available clicking on <u>Geneva Foundation for Medical Education and Research What's new on the GFMER home page</u>. In this page you will find a list of the new published files of the Foundation.
- c. Click on <u>Training Course in Sexual and Reproductive Health Research 2011 List of files in alphabetical order</u> on <u>SRH course 2011</u>. You will find a list of all files of the course.

2. How do I find presentations with audio?

- a. Follow Step 1a. Click on <u>Presentations with audio</u>. Click on the relevant audio presentation.
- b. Follow Step 1b to link the individual courses or go to course file. You will find presentation with audio if there is one for the required course. Click on it.

3. How can I find assignments?

- a. Not all courses have assignments. For those that have, the assignments are written on the page linking to the PDF version of the courses.
- b. Follow Step 1a. Click on <u>Assignments</u> to get to the page with links to all available assignments for the entire course. Click on the one that applies.

4. Are there FAQ on assignments?

Yes. Assignments FAQ is accessible from SRH course 2011 and from Assignments.

5. Published assignments?

a. Click on <u>Training Course in Sexual and Reproductive Health Research 2011 - What's new?</u> on <u>SRH course 2011</u>. Go through the lists of files by date to find any published assignment presented by participants.

b. Published assignments are also available from <u>Assignments</u> and from pages linking to PDF presentations with assignments under *Assignment presented by the participants*.

7. Databases, links?
