Research fellow of the Hospital Clinic of Barcelona (IDIBAPS) during 2006-2007, where I trained as a specialist in Fetal Medicine within the Maternal Fetal Medicine Service. Doctor of Medicine from the University of Barcelona, with the thesis “Perinatal and neurodevelopmental outcome of late-onset growth restricted fetuses”. Master's Degree in Research Methodology in Health Sciences from the Autonomous University of Barcelona.

I am currently a full professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Faculty of

Medicine of the University of Zaragoza. I carry out my clinical work in the Medicine Unit of the Obstetrics and Gynecology Service of the Lozano Blesa University Clinical Hospital in Zaragoza. I am also the principal investigator of the group "Placental pathophysiology and fetal programming" of the Health Research Institute of Aragon.

I am scientific editor of the British Journal Obstetrics and Gynecology (BJOG) as well as "Visitor Research Fellow" of the Oxford Maternal and Perinatal Health Institute (OMPHI) at the University of Oxford. During 10 years, I have been a board member and coordinator of teaching and protocols of the Perinatal Medicine Section of the Spanish Society of Gynecology and Obstetrics. My lines of research are developed in relation to restricted intrauterine growth, preeclampsia and preterm delivery.
