Report on training of Interpractice- 21st e-learning course on preterm infant feeding and growth monitoring, Karachi, Pakistan

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The Liaquat National Hospital (LNH) was established in 1958 with four out-patient services and 50 beds for the in-patients. Over the years hospital progressed and become one of the largest tertiary care hospital in the country with more than 700 beds and 35 specialties providing modern diagnostic and therapeutic facilities.
